Many developing countries or countries in transition lack a solid land-administration system. In many cases, they also lack the financial means for realising it. International financial institutes offer the possibility of budget loans, so that countries can contract expert parties. Kadaster is a party contracted on a regular basis. Project execution often includes photogrammetry, field visits to each parcel, establishment of registers and cadastral maps, public inspection and delivery of titles to the right holders. ## Our activities

### Analysis

Creating a detailed work plan. Making an inventory of the existing legal and geometric data. Describing the desired situation regarding the organisation, human resources, work processes and IT.

### Methodology

After creating photogrammetric images, all parcels are registered and measured during field visits. The results are open for inspection and objection. Afterwards, the right holders receive their titles. The (IT)system is described.

### Implementation and Training

Establishing an implementation plan for: organisation and system roll-out, personell selection, infrastructure, data implementation, data and system maintenance. Executing a training programme, both for staff and stakeholders.
