**Namibia, 1998:** *Institutional Support and HR Development at Ministry of Lands, Resettlement and Rehabilitation*

- Financed by the World Bank, \$1.2m (sub-contracting to ITC, Int. Institute for Aerospace and Earth Sciences)
- Strengthening the managerial capacity of the Ministry, designing and implementing a National Certificate training course in Land Registration at the Polytechnic of Namibia, including the provision of trainers.



**Egypt, 2003:** *Training Programme for the National Cadastre at the Egyptian Survey Authority*

- Financed by the Dutch Government, \$0.08m (sub-contracting to ITC)
- Providing staff for a training programme for management and supervising staff of the National Cadastre, both in Cairo and the Netherlands. Hosting study visits for groups studying in the Netherlands.

**Guatemala, 2004-2006:** *Design and Implementation of the Technical Study Programme in Land Administration*

- Financed by the Dutch Government (NUFFIC), €1.15m (sub-contracting to ITC)
- Defining the study plan, staff planning and specialisation programme in land administration. Strengthening governing bodies, project monitoring and evaluation. Carrying out institutional analysis, developing user groups.
